- The nominee's consistent contributions of time and energy above-and-beyond the regular effort that improves the workplace and quality of life for residents and staff.
- The nominee's ability to contribute to the community, as well as the facility.
- The nominee's contributions towards fostering a positive image of their facility and long term care community through their dedication and deeds.
